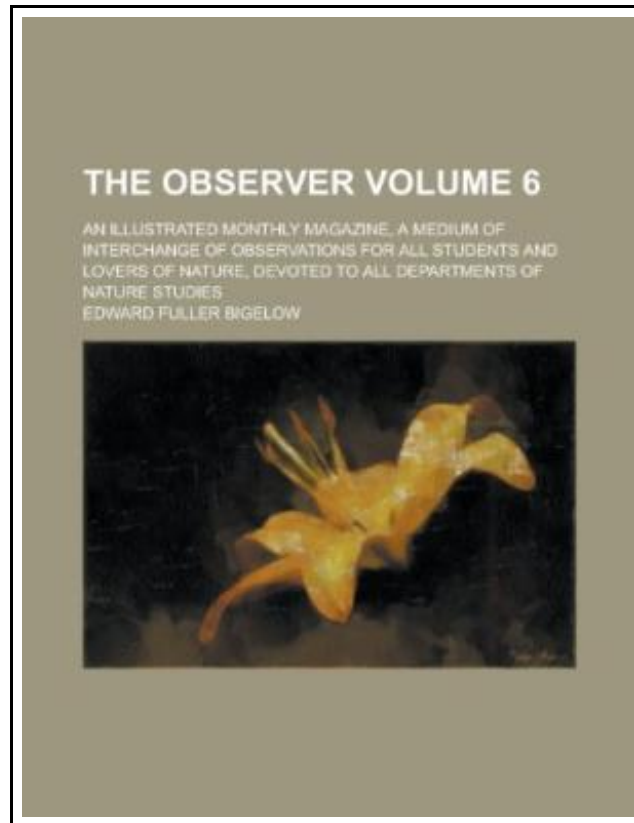

In certain sections of Rhode Island large flights of hawks may be seen during the latter part of August, and through September and October, whenever there is a stormy north-west wind. Having had the good fortune to be present during their flights I have had abundant opportunity to study them. They seem to follow the coast, as three miles back from the shore only a few stragglers can be found. During September I have taken specimens of the pigeon, sparrow, coopers, broad-winged, red-shoildered, red-tailed, marsh, sharpshiniied, duck and goshawk. A great many hawks are shot by local gunners and farmers, as they claim they are during these flights very destructive to poultry. In my opinion they seldom kill poultry, as of sixty hawks examined...
