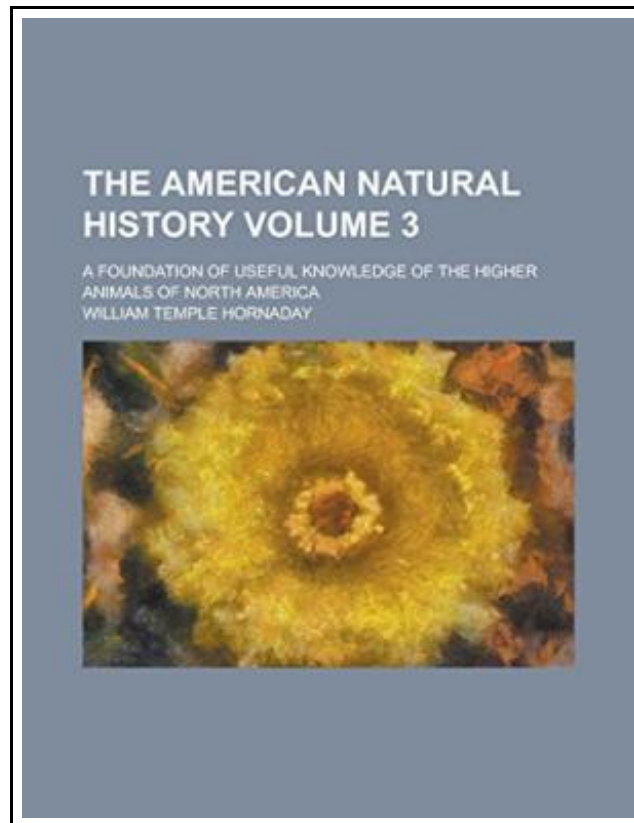

While the most typical rails have long bills, some species are short-billed. A Gallinule is a bird which lives, acts and looks like a rail, and is easily mistaken for either a rail or a coot; but it stands midway between the two. It is distinguished from the rails by the bare, horny shield upon the forehead, and from the coots by the long, slender, unwebbed toes. The Florida Gallinule¹ is also called the Blue Rail, and Red-Billed Mud-Hen, and its general color effect is bluish gray. It is found in localities adapted to its habits throughout temperate North America, north to Canada, and as far south as Brazil. The Purple Gallinule,² of the southern half of the eastern United States, is a bird of beautiful plumage. Its colors are a rich, dark purple on the head, neck and shoulders, lightening to peacock blue on the back and lower breast.
