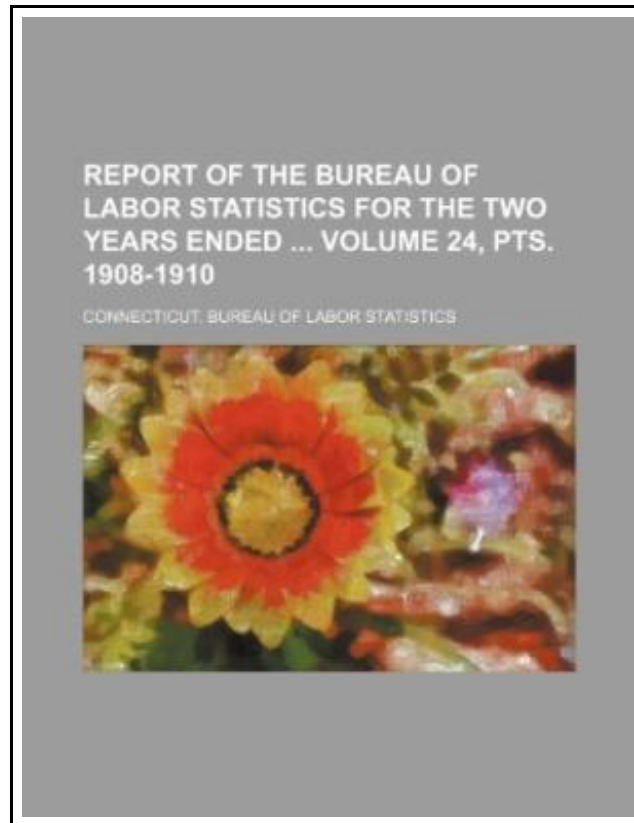

Those of the strikers who were wanted and were willing to return were taken back, but the others were paid off and given to understand they were wanted no more. New men were secured to fill the vacancies. A strike affecting thirty-five men employed as cement mixers by the Sperry Engineering Company at Old Saybrook, took place March 11, 1910. Eight days time elapsed before a settlement was reached which was reported to have been satisfactory to the striking employes. . An incipient strike, in which ninety-seven employes of the Mystic Woolen Company at Old Mystic were involved, was inaugurated March 15th. The cause of the difficulty was the demand on the part of the employes that an increase be made in prices paid for certain work. But one days time was lost when a settlement was reached of which a newspaper published in a neighboring city, printed the following March 16th: The Mystic Woolen Co. of Old Mystic had a strike on its hands Monday when its employes quit in the afternoon to get a raise of ten cents a cut on the shoddy the mill turns out. The increase was granted and work resumed on Tuesday morning. Because of the refusal of various employing painters and decorators to grant an increased wage rate ninety men employed as...
